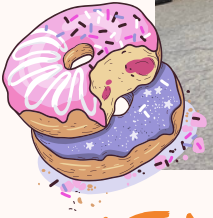

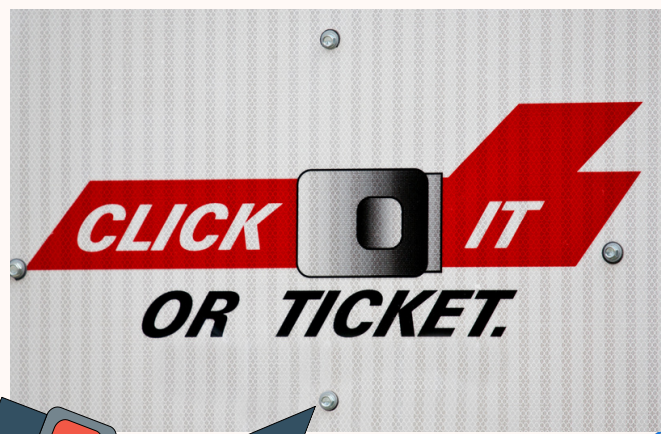
Slow Down!

It's that time of year again! Kids are headed back to school and that means an increase in traffic from school buses, pedestrians, and cyclists. Keep them safe - slow down in school zones.

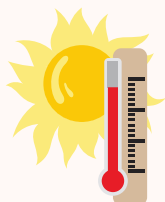
REMEMBER!
