- Terms:** 4 Years, unlimited number of terms
- Duties:** Advise and make recommendations to the City Manager regarding the care, preservation, pruning, planting and removal of trees, shrubs, bushes and all other vegetation in parks, along streets and all other public places in the City. Members should be gardeners, arborists, landscape designers, architects to the extent possible or other persons interested in the appearance of the city.
