The items in the memo are those which staff recommends the consultant use as the rate schedule is developed. I have reviewed these items with Mr. Stoneham and they come to you with my recommendation for support.

If there are any modifications which Council would want to make to the recommendations you are requested to do so. Any changes, when adopted by Council, will then be forwarded to the consultant. The consultant will return to Council in January 2010 with a recommended rate schedule based on his analysis and your recommendations.

On October 26, 2009 City Council was presented the preliminary results of the Financial Review and Allocated Cost of Service Analysis. The review showed that current projected revenues do not meet revenue requirements and there is a projected deficit net income after Transfer to General Fund. At the present time, the Reserve Fund Balance which is our financial protection against unforeseen events is below 2 months revenue, and our cash balance in the Electric Fund has fallen from approximately \$1, 900,000 on 9/30/2007 to \$1,060,000 on 9/30/2009.

Following the presentation, I have met with each City Council member to answer questions and to seek guidance on what directions we should give our consultant for developing new rate schedules.

With City Council's input I make the following recommendations for guidance to be given to our consultant, GDS Associates, for determining a new rate schedule for Franklin Power and Light.

1. All rate schedules should remain competitive with neighboring utilities.
2. Due to uncertain economic conditions and the impact of International Paper closing the Franklin mill, the Transfer to General Funds should remain at its current annual rate of \$1,559,891.
3. Projected kWh sales will remain level or possibly decrease from 2009 levels.
4. The new rates should increase total revenue by 6% to remove the projected deficit net income, achieve positive operating income for all rate classes and begin to raise the cash balance of the Electric Fund to \$2,500,000 over a 7-year period.
5. Rates will be reviewed again mid summer 2010 when we have projected 2011 power costs from VMEA and better economic indicators. They will be reviewed annually thereafter.

6. Develop a special rate category for places of worship similar to Dominion Virginia Power's Schedule 5C Church and Synagogue Service that does not contain a kW demand charge. The applicability of this schedule shall be limited to the meter that serves the synagogue or church building in which the sanctuary or principal place of worship is located.
7. Due to the new Power Purchase Agreement, the existing Electric Load Control Rate will need to be terminated before 12/31/2010. Presently, Southampton Memorial Hospital is the only customer on this rate.
8. Small General Service rate should be adjusted to bring Relative ROR down and more comparative to other commercial rates.
9. Customer Charges have not been adjusted in almost 9 years. They should be revised to reflect current costs.
10. Preliminary revised retail rates to be developed for City Council's review on January 11, 2010.
11. Final revised retail rates to be developed for presentation at City Council meeting on January 25, 2010.
12. Revised retail rate schedule effective March 1, 2010.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Citizens' Time

Ronnie McClenny. 1440 Clay Street. Mr. McClenny read aloud a letter he had written to Mrs. Fleming requesting to purchase his weapon, receive his concealed weapons permit and his retired police credentials.

Vice Mayor Johnson interrupted Mr. McClenny to get a consensus from Council that he was violating the rules and procedures of the meeting by speaking unfavorably about a City employee. The consensus of Council was to allow Mr. McClenny to continue only if he could speak without addressing City employees critically.

Amber Stansbury, Interim Director of Finance, presented Council with Budget Amendments 2010-16, 2010-17, 2010-18, 2010-19 and the October Financial Report.

On motion made by Mr. Burgess and seconded by Mr. Cheatham, Budget Amendments 2010-16, 2010-17, 2010-18 and 2010-19 were approved by Council. Community Development

Donald Goodwin, Director of Community Development, presented Council with a grant opportunity from the Virginia Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy that would purchase new lighting at the Ruth Camp Campbell Memorial Library.

On motion made by Mrs. Hilliard and seconded by Mr. Cheatham, Council authorized Mayor Council to endorse a letter to the Virginia Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy assuring that the City of Franklin will comply with the Davis-Bacon Act for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program. Public Hearing on Barrett's Landing Lease Matter

Taylor Williams, City Attorney, presented Council with the proposed lease conditions for the Barrett's Landing property.

- a. Lease would be for 15 years because that time period mirrors the term of the loan;
- b. Rent would be \$1 per year due and payable 15 days after City issues Certificate of Occupancy upon completion of construction and final inspection and renewed annually the same date each subsequent year;
- c. DFA responsible for insurances such as flood ins., hazard ins., general liability ins. on the building;
- d. DFA responsible for utilities such as electric, HAVC, telephone, cable, internet, water and sewer; etc.;
- e. DFA responsible for real estate taxes (DFA is tax exempt at present);
- f. DFA responsible for maintenance, upkeep and repairs to the building;
- g. No assignment of lease to a third party without written consent of City;
- h. In the event the building is destroyed by some disaster, the City has no responsibility to reconstruct the facility, and DFA has no requirement to reconstruct the building;
- i. DFA agreement that any event taking place at Barrett's Landing will have access to the bathroom facilities for a fee to cover the cost of cleaning after the event, electric, water and sewer and maintenance;

- j. Ability to rent the building other than the bathroom for a separate fee from bathroom to be determined by DFA;
- k. Option for DFA to renew the lease agreement for successive 5 year terms at some rent to be negotiated at the time the option to renew is exercised ;
- l. Agreement that upon termination of the lease the improvements to the real estate (the building) will become the property of the City;
- m. Agreement that DFA will keep current its obligations to BB&T and make all mortgage payments in a timely fashion;
- n. Agreement that the facility cannot be used for residential purposes;
- o. DFA would grant an easement to the City of Franklin for ingress and egress on the leased property for the City at all times and to the public during those occasions that events are taking place;
- p. City would grant to DFA an easement of ingress and egress in the area around the building;
- q. The City would be responsible for cutting the grass not covered with landscape at the same time that Barrett's Landing grass is cut.

Dan Howe, Director of the Downtown Franklin Association, advised Council that the DFA was in receipt of a \$25,000 grant from the Franklin Southampton Charities for the construction of the multi-purpose building.

The public hearing was opened for comments.

Scott Seden commented on how embarrassed the elderly and handicapped are when trying to use the porta-johns during events at Barrett's Landing.

Anne Williams, Director of Marketing for Southampton Memorial Hospital, commented on how the building would enhance the beauty and marketability of the park.

Bobby Tyler apologized to any DFA volunteers he may have offended during the last meeting and stated that he is now in favor of the project.

With no one else wanting to speak, the public hearing was closed.

On motion made by Ms. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Cheatham, Council authorized the City Attorney to proceed with negotiating a lease with the Downtown Franklin Association. The vote on this motion was as follows: AYE: Barry Cheatham, Benny Burgess, Raystine Johnson, Mary Hilliard, Mark Fetherolf and James P. Councill, III. ABSENT: Rosa Lawrence.

On motion made by Mrs. Hilliard and seconded by Mr. Burgess, Council waived \$8,000 for tap fees for the construction of the building. The vote on this motion was as follows: AYE: Barry Cheatham, Benny Burgess, Raystine Johnson, Mary Hilliard, Mark Fetherolf and James P. Councill, III. ABSENT: Rosa Lawrence.

Council agreed to table this matter until a later date.

Councilman Cheatham gave an update on SPSA. The biggest news was that the Waste to Energy plant was being sold to Wheelabrator.

Councilman Burgess advised that he recently had a meeting with the City Manager, Interim Director of Finance and representatives from Davenport and Company regarding debt restructuring. A report is expected to be presented to Council in early 2010.

Councilman Cheatham announced that the Business Friendly Meeting is scheduled for December 2nd at City Hall and the public is welcome to attend.

Mayor Council gave an update on the International Paper situation.

On motion made by Mr. Burgess and seconded by Ms. Johnson, Benny Burgess would serve on the Economic Development Committee and Raystine Johnson would serve on the Workforce Development Committee, as previously appointed. June Fleming, City Manager, read an email that indicated a citizen was looking to begin a food drive in early 2010 for the International Paper employees.

Hair Designs is offering free haircuts for IP employees that have job interviews. A local massage therapist is offering free massages on Mondays to IP employees as well.

Declaration of Local Emergency on November 12, 2009

DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY ON NOVEMBER 12, 2009 BY THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, VIRGINIA DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

1. A nor'easter storm began dumping rain on southeastern Virginia and the east coast of the State of Virginia on Wednesday, November 11, 2009 and it is projected to rain until Friday, November 13, 2009; and
2. Said rain event has caused and continues to cause an extreme amount of rain to fall in the watershed of the Blackwater River above the City of Franklin with projected subsequent flooding of low lying areas adjacent to and along the Blackwater River; and
3. Said flood elevation at the City of Franklin along the Blackwater River is 12 feet and this rain event along the Blackwater River is predicted to crest at 14-15 feet by the National Weather Service, Wakefield, Virginia location which would produce probable and potential flooding in the Downtown Franklin, Virginia area thereby affecting numerous businesses and residences; and
4. This event will require the evacuation of certain areas along, at a minimum, Broad Street, Mechanic Street, Bowers Road and a portion of Franklin Street and possibly some businesses along Main Street and South Streets; among others, and
5. That as a result of the aforementioned flooding accompanying the nor'easter, the City of Franklin is facing a condition of extreme peril which would put into jeopardy the lives and property of the residents of the City; and

6. That as a result of this extreme peril, the declaration of the existence of an emergency is necessary to permit the full powers of City government to deal with this condition of peril; and

7. That during the existence of this emergency, the powers, functions and duties of the Director of Emergency Services (the City Manager), the Coordinator of Emergency Services (the Chief of the Department of Emergency Services – Fire and Rescue), the Deputy Coordinator of Emergency Services (the Deputy Chief of Emergency Services – Fire and Rescue) emergency services organizations and City departments would be those prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the ordinances, resolutions and emergency operations plan of the City of Franklin, Virginia in order to mitigate the effects of such emergency; and

8. That the City Manager, the Interim Director of Finance and their designees, are hereby authorized to expend funds from the City's unappropriated fund balances to cover the reasonable operational costs of emergency services as would be deemed necessary to cover the expected scope of the emergency, subject to subsequent ratification of such expenditures by City Council.

9. Now, therefore, I, June Fleming, Director of Emergency Services for the City of Franklin, Virginia, do hereby proclaim and declare that a local emergency exists in the City of Franklin, Virginia effective on the 12th day of November, 2009.

Resolution Ratifying and Consenting to Declaration of Local Emergency

RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND CONSENTING TO DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY ON NOVEMBER 12, 2009

Whereas, the Director of Emergency Services of the City of Franklin, Virginia did find on November 12, 2009 as follows:

1. That a Nor'easter generating rainfall in excess of ____ inches was approaching the City of Franklin, Virginia from a northeasterly direction and was expected to cause severe flooding of the Blackwater River which meanders along the eastern boundary of the City; and,

2. That as a result of possible flooding which might have accompanied this nor'easter the City of Franklin was facing a condition of extreme peril which would put into jeopardy the lives and property of the residents of the city; and

3. That as a result of this extreme peril, the declaration of the existence of an emergency was necessary to permit the full powers of city government to deal with this condition of peril; and

4. That the City Council could not convene due to the exigent circumstances; and

5. That on November 12, 2009, pursuant to Section 44-146.21 of the Code of Virginia, the Director of Emergency Services proclaimed and declared that a local emergency existed in the City of Franklin, Virginia; and

6. That during the existence of the emergency the powers, functions and duties of the Director of Emergency Services (the City Manager), the Coordinator of Emergency Services (the Chief of the Fire and Rescue Department), the Deputy Coordinator of Emergency Services (the Deputy Chief of the Fire and Rescue Department), emergency services organizations and city departments would be those prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the ordinances, resolutions and emergency operations plan of the City of Franklin, Virginia in order to mitigate the effects of such emergency; and

7. That the City Manager, the Interim Director of Finance and their designees, were authorized to expend funds from the City's unappropriated fund balances to cover the reasonable operational costs of emergency services as would be deemed necessary to cover the expected scope of the emergency, subject to subsequent ratification of such expenditures by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 44-146.21 of the Code of Virginia, the City Council of the City of Franklin, Virginia hereby RESOLVES that it does ratify, confirm and consent to the actions of the Director of Emergency Services in proclaiming and declaring that a local emergency existed in the City of Franklin, Virginia beginning on November 12, 2009 and the actions taken by the Director of Emergency Services, the Coordinator of Emergency Services, the Deputy Coordinator of Emergency Services and members of city departments in responding to the local emergency.

On motion made by Ms. Johnson and seconded by Mrs. Hilliard, the above Resolution was approved by Council. The vote on this motion was as follows: AYE: Mr. Cheatham, Mr. Burgess, Mrs. Lawrence, Ms. Johnson, Mrs. Hilliard, Mr. Fetherolf and Mr. Council. ABSENT: none.

BUDGET AMENDMENT 2010-20

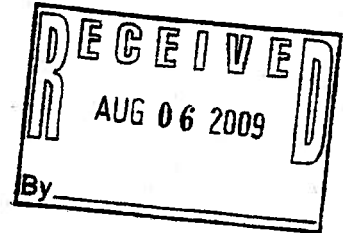

DATE: December 8, 2009

Council will recall that you have expressed concern that the charges from the City of Franklin to Isle of Wight for sewer flow have been left unresolved too long. I was instructed to make every attempt to find a resolution. I would note that I have been working on this issue since I was appointed in July 2008.

I have read every item in city files related to this issue that I could locate; I have gone through the related issues and the charges with staff in an effort to discover why the amount owed by Isle of Wight varied from the \$400,000 plus range to the \$100,000 plus range. Additionally I have met with consultants and had repeated conversations with my Isle of Wight counterpart, County Administrator Douglas Caskey. We have exchanged numerous e-mails and only this past week have we come to a point where resolution may be in sight. Mr. Caskey and I are making the following proposal to our governing body's and need your direction so we can either convert the concept to a binding agreement or once again restart the discussions.

My recommendation is that you direct staff to complete the necessary documentation to implement the following proposal.

1. Isle of Wight County will agree to pay \$270,000 to the City of Franklin to bring current all expenses related to the treatment of sewage.

Discussion - This is purely an arbitrary figure that falls between the amounts Franklin has previously indicated was the amount owed and the amount that Isle of Wight has stated is the amount owed. As the amount owed is investigated no sound defensible evidence can be documented for support of either figure. More investment of time and hiring of consultants may reach a figure somewhere between the two. Rather than expend that time and funds the compromise amount is recommended.

2. The County of Isle of Wight will agree to a sewage rate of \$2.036 per million gallons for the current months of December, January and February. A new mutually agreeable treatment rate will be negotiated in time to put in place in March 1, 2010 when the current rate expires.

Discussion - We have this related issue which remains unresolved and that is the rate per million gallons to charge Isle of Wight. It is an appropriate time to resolve that issue so that a new rate can be agreed to in time for the new contract agreement which is March 1, 2010. This proposed rate of \$2.036 is one Mr. Caskey and I can recommend.

3. Monitoring System: A new monitoring system is urgently needed and the City of Franklin will accept that responsibility.

Discussion - One of the basic problems that reappeared as we tried to resolve the sewer flow payment was the condition of the monitoring system. A new system needs to be installed. It also appears logically that the system should belong to the City of Franklin. Staff can monitor the condition and functioning of the system and be held accountable. The City of Franklin then becomes responsible for the metering as we do for other services we provide which require metering. Due to the past history of disputes about the metering and in an effort to be open about our operations it is proposed that the City of Franklin grant Isle of Wight access to review data and records from the system regarding flows.

This proposal comes to you thanks to the support I have received from staff and the City Attorney, Taylor Williams, and my counterpart County Administrator, Douglas Caskey.

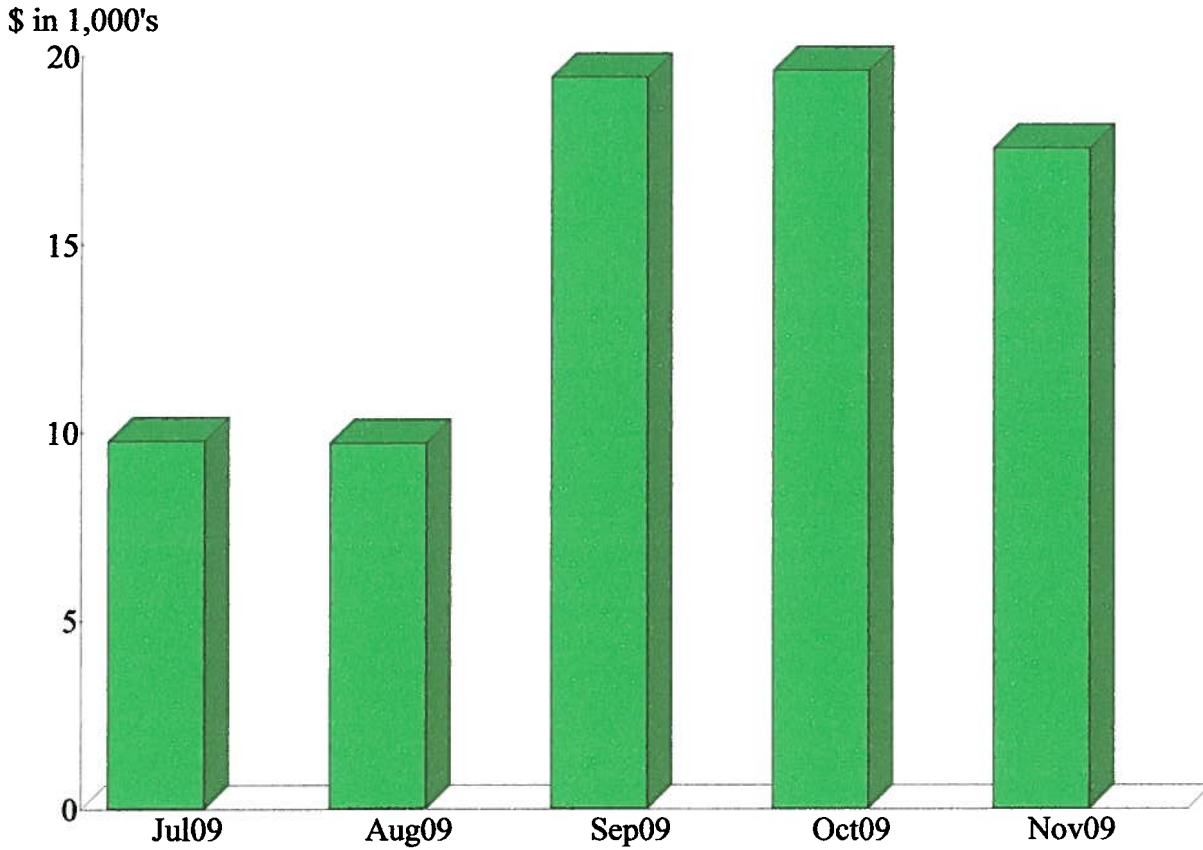

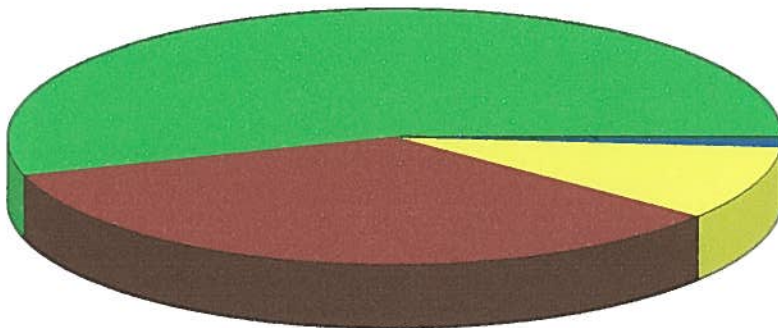
Sales by Month

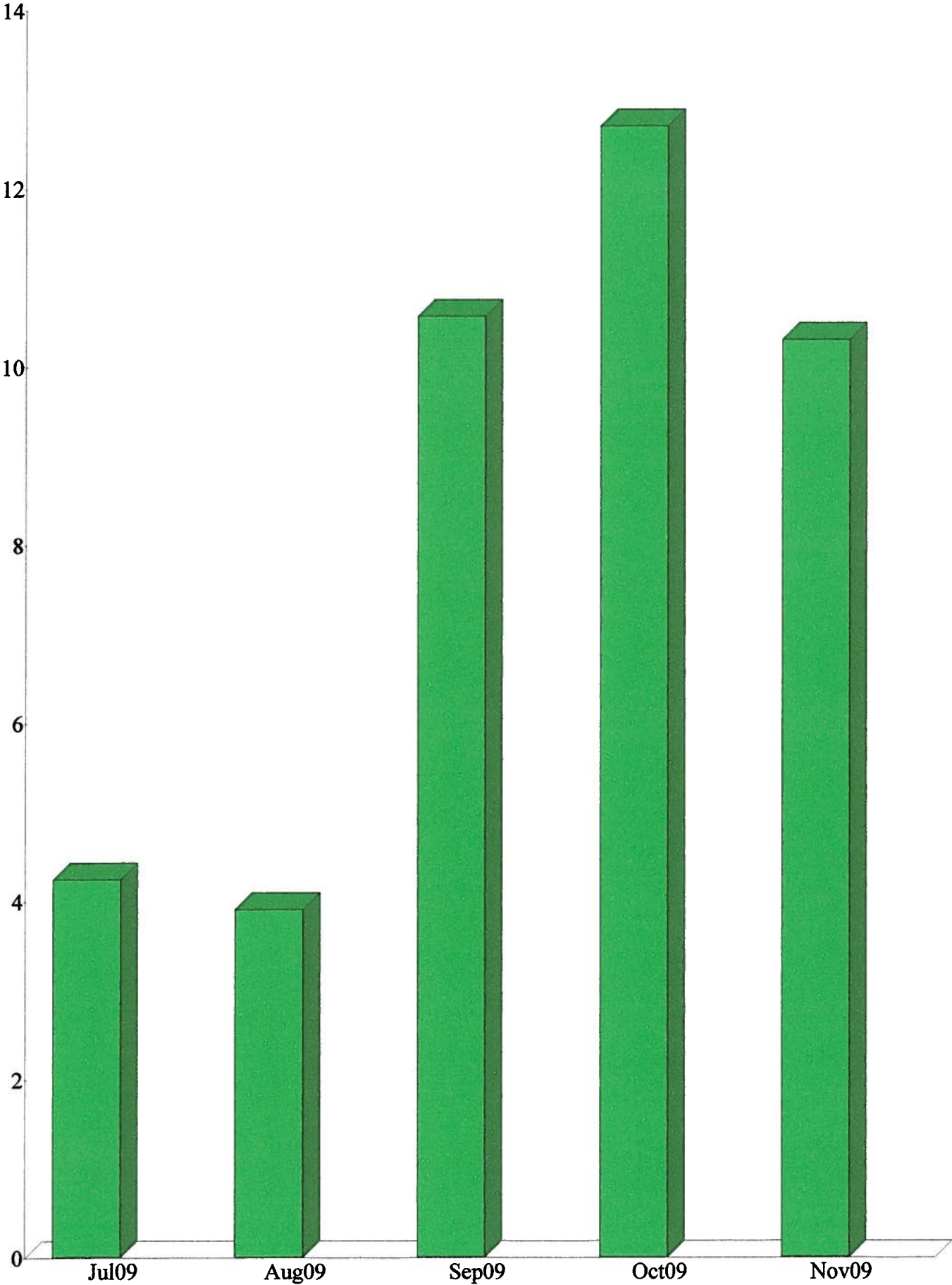

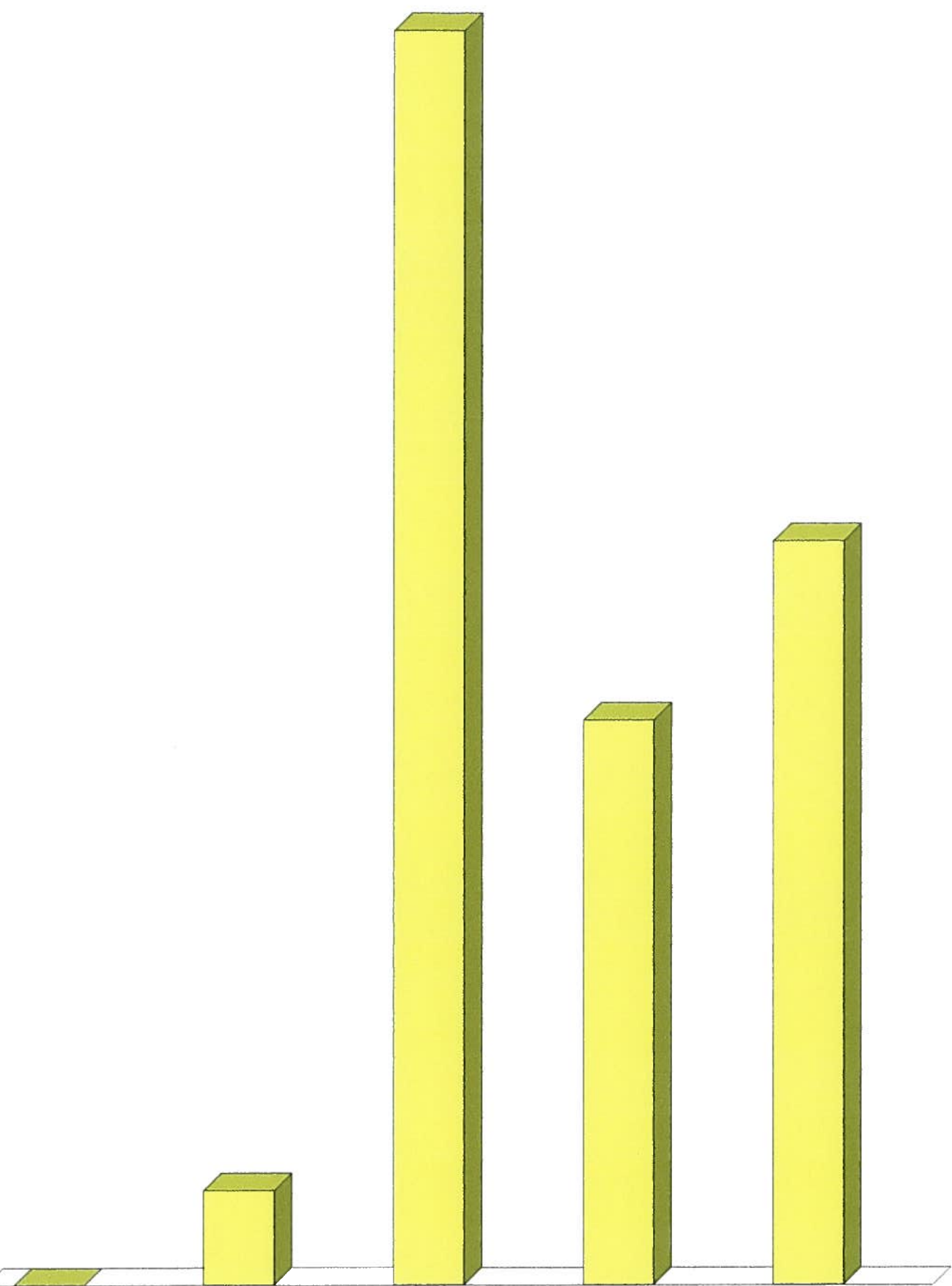
