Key Note Speaker – Dr. Makola M. Abdullah – President, Virginia State University



On 1 February 2016, Dr. Abdullah was officially named the 14<sup>th</sup> President of Virginia State University, a Historically Black, Land-Grant University (one of two in the Commonwealth of Virginia) located in Chesterfield County, Virginia. He earned his undergraduate degree from Howard University in civil engineering. He attended Northwestern University for his master's and doctoral studies. At 24, he became the youngest African American in Northwestern's history to receive a Ph.D. in engineering.

Dr. Abdullah and his wife, Dr. Ahkinyala Cobb-Abdullah, are both natives of Chicago, Illinois. They are the proud parents of two college students, Mikaili and Sefiyetu, who both are attending a historically black university.
