Real Estate and Person Property Taxes were **DUE** on December 05, 2016. If you were unable to pay your taxes, PLEASE come by the office and set up your taxes on a payment plan. For more information, please call 757-562-8544 or 757-562-8543. A down payment will be required at the time of signing a payment plan agreement with the office.

Don't forget to get your Pet License Tag for 2017. You will need the Rabies Certificate showing a current rabies vaccination. All Pets in the City of Franklin are required to have a Pet License before January 31, 2017. For more information call 757-562-8536 and speak to any cashier.

The Treasurer's Office continues to sell Virginia *E-ZPasses*. Come by the office and purchase your *E-ZPass* and start saving money when driving on toll roads!

 2016 Virginia State Income Tax Forms will not be mailed to individual taxpayers. The Commissioner of the Revenue's Office has a limited number of forms and instruction booklets for distribution. Forms and instructions are available on demand through the following options:

- Download, view or print forms directly from the Department of Taxation website at www.tax.virginia.gov.
- Order forms online through the Department's website or call (804) 367-8031.

If you fill out your tax return by hand, you can avoid processing delays by printing your information so it can be easily read. Please use black ink and not pencil.

Effective January 1, 2017 – local Commissioner of the Revenue Offices will no longer be able to process accelerated refunds for taxpayers. We can accept your return and audit for mistakes or omissions but we will be mailing them directly to Richmond for processing. This is all due to identity theft and refund fraud.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO GET MY REFUND?

- Up to 4 weeks for e-filed returns
- Up to 8 weeks for paper returns
- Up to 3 additional weeks if sent by certified mail

Refund Fraud Prevention

The Virginia Department of Taxation takes the protection of your information seriously.

Additional Steps to Protect You - and the Commonwealth

As identify theft and refund fraud become more widespread, we are enlisting the support of taxpayers, tax preparers, employers, and payroll providers to stop tax fraud. This year, we may request additional information from you to verify your return. In addition, we may take longer than in previous years to process your tax return.

We are committed to safeguarding taxpayer information.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Take these steps to protect yourself from identity theft and refund fraud:

 Do not provide personal information by mail, phone, email, or text to an unknown person

- File your taxes early- and file electronically
- Be sure you have all W-2s and other withholding statements before you file

 Include your Virginia Driver's License Identification number and Issue Date on your return (optional)

If you are a victim of identity theft, we suggest you consider all of the following steps:

- Contact the three credit bureaus and your bank(s) to notify them
- Contact your local police or sheriff's department to file a criminal complaint
- Submit Form 14039 Identity Theft Affidavit to the IRS
- Contact the Virginia Department of Taxation's Identity Theft Information line at 804-404-418
