

At the request of Lee Copeland, Public Safety Administrator for the Town of Ivor, Willis Scott and I made a site visit at the referenced inspection location to determine if the storage warehouse was structurally unsafe.

The following notes are our findings at that location:

- 1) The building was originally built to house bulk peanuts.
- 2) Interior cable restraints were installed to offset any pressure on the outside walls.
- 3) Cables currently are slack and are not under tension.
- 4) Missing exterior doors.

The warehouse seems to be structurally sound due to limited leakage from the roof and no signs of deterioration of structural members.

The warehouse building should be secured from public access to prevent it from becoming an attractive nuisance. Any grade level access ladders should be removed to a safe height.

The elevator building needs some repairs to structural members and also remove access ladders.
