No further environmental progression - still awaiting to receive fees. In May, the Community Development Department received the required load letter from the contractor, Kenbridge Construction. On June 10th. Ms. Smith received the Stormwater Management fee, the land disturbance fee, and the issued surety bonds. On July 1st, Ms. Smith hosted the preconstruction meeting for Kenbridge Construction. On July 2nd, Kenbridge was given the "ok" to begin land disturbance on the site. So far, they have intalled initial E&S meausres, established temporary utilities, demolished the former building. On Tuesday, 7/20, Kenbridge didcovered a diesel spill on site - upon demolition, the crew unknowingly struck an unidentified underground fuel storage tank. City of Franklin nor DEQ tank registration showed existance of the tank. The spill was self contained, and did not pose threat to spreading/contaminating surrounding areas. Bay Environmental Inc was immediately called for clean-up. Ms. Smith contacted VDEM, DEQ, and Franklin staff to report the spill. The site has now been cleaned and the storage tank has been properly removed - Kenbridge will continue with construction according to plan. Construction is well underway and moving nicely.






