- Start looking at river and swamp bridge crossings or ditches in your area and scope out a place for your team to clean. There are plenty of storm water ditches in Franklin that need attention.
- If your group wants to participate contact either Anne or Dick by March 31. Tell us the location and date you have picked. If you want to be assigned an area, let us know.
- Keep track of the number of bags and tires you pick up and report this to Anne or Dick by the end of April.
 Please also report any unusual trash that you found. Email us pictures of the cleanup so that we can
 publicize the event. Trash bags collected in Franklin may be left at the boat ramp at Barrett's Landing, in
 the rear of Hunterdale Christian Church on Delaware Road, in home trash containers or taken to the SPSA
 transfer station at 30521 General Thomas Highway. Trash collected in Southampton County may be left at
 one of the dumpster collection sites in the county.


